**AIRPORT OFFERS AIRCRAFT RESCUE FIRE FIGHTING (ARFF) TRAINING EXPERIENCE**

Casper / Natrona County International Airport is offering an opportunity for new media reporters/photographers to experience a live fire training exercise at the Airport. The Airport has a burn scheduled for Friday, September 16<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 am. The Airport welcomes news reporters/photographers to come out to the Airport to experience a truck burn by actually operating the Airport's ARFF regional training vehicle (in essence driving the truck with an instructor present and operating the roof turret).



If you are interested in participating in this training or to simply photograph/video tape a burn, we will need to know no later than 4:00 pm on Wednesday, September 14<sup>th</sup>. Contact Glenn Januska at the number/e-mail above.

Since 1995 the Airport has trained, through the Wyoming ARFF Training Facility, over 1,800 fire fighters from over 70 different departments. Every year an aircraft fire fighter is required to participate in a live burn to maintain certification. The Airport's regional training facility is the only facility in Wyoming and one of the few facilities in the country that uses hydrocarbons.
