**ALLEGiant AIR REDUCES FALL SCHEDULE IN CASPER
Seasonal Adjustment Begins Mid-August**

CASPER, WY – Casper / Natrona County International Airport announced that Allegiant Air will suspend their Casper/Las Vegas flights following the August 17th departure and will resume service November 9th. Allegiant has indicated that the reason for the seasonal stoppage is due to decreased leisure travel demand during the fall months. “My first reaction to this news was disappointment,” said Glenn Januska, Airport Manager. “But in thinking about it, each airline in our market makes seasonal adjustments by decreasing flights in the fall. By eliminating the least profitable months Allegiant can keep the route’s performance high during the remaining months. Ultimately this helps the longevity of the route and helps ensure Allegiant’s continued success in our market.”

This practice is nothing new for Allegiant. “They have seasonally discontinued routes every year,” said Januska. “This year, based on the cost of fuel, they indicated they are doing it more than they have in years past.”
