**BOEING 787 ARRIVAL AT NOON**

The Airport has been notified that a Boeing 787 will be arriving at the Airport today at noon. We do not know at this time if the aircraft will be performing touch and go's, full stop landings, low approaches, or how long the aircraft may be here. Times are subject to change. We will update the media on what we know when we know it. This could be a great photo opportunity.

From the Boeing website: The 787-8 Dreamliner will carry 210 - 250 passengers on routes of 7,650 to 8,200 nautical miles (14,200 to 15,200 kilometers), while the 787-9 Dreamliner will carry 250 - 290 passengers on routes of 8,000 to 8,500 nautical miles (14,800 to 15,750 kilometers). In addition to bringing big-jet ranges to mid-size airplanes, the 787 will provide airlines with unmatched fuel efficiency, resulting in exceptional environmental performance. The airplane will use 20 percent less fuel for comparable missions than today's similarly sized airplane. It will also travel at speeds similar to today's fastest wide bodies, Mach 0.85. Airlines will enjoy more cargo revenue capacity. Passengers will also see improvements with the new



airplane, from an interior environment with higher humidity to increased comfort and convenience.
