

**NOTICE OF FINAL ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT
AND FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT**
For the Casper/Natrona County Airport Improvement Projects

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has approved a Final EA and a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the proposed relocation of the airport traffic control tower (ATCT) at the Casper/Natrona County Airport (CPR) in Casper, Wyoming. The purpose of this notice is to announce the availability of the final documents.

CPR is proposing to relocate the existing ATCT. The existing tower has line-of-sight (LOS) issues for multiple critical areas of the airport and is a non-standard design. The Proposed Actions are illustrated on Figure 1-5 in the Final EA.

The proposed project includes:

- Demolition of the existing ATCT and associated buildings.
- Construction of a new ATCT and terminal radar approach control facility (TRACON), which includes:
 - Installation of ancillary equipment and exterior chillers and generators.
 - Construction of new base building and parking lot.
 - Relocation of existing rotating beacon and security fencing.
- Coordination with FAA technical operations personnel to support the orderly transfer of air traffic control equipment and services prior to and during commissioning of the proposed new ATCT.

The Final EA and FONSI found that the project is consistent with existing environmental policies and objectives as set forth in the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 and will not significantly affect the quality of the human environment.

In accordance with current Council on Environmental Quality regulations, copies of the FONSI and Final EA will be available for public review until December 15, 2024.
