CASPER / NATRONA COUNTY INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT
ANTICIPATES FLIGHT IMPACTS FROM FAA AIR TRAFFIC REDUCTION

CASPER, WY – The Casper/Natrona County International Airport (C/NCIA) is anticipating that Casper travelers will see some flight cancellations caused by the FAA and DOT reduction in flights across 40 major airports in the US.

“We understand that maintaining the safest air transportation system is the top priority, and therefore understand the necessity for the flight reductions,” said Airport Director Glenn Januska. “Thus far we have been lucky to not have seen any delays or cancellations due to shutdown caused staffing concerns, and we are greatly appreciative to our federal partners who continue showing up for our travelers.”

United, and other airlines have already begun alerting travelers to changes in their flight schedules. Travelers should make sure their information is accurate and up to date with their airline(s) and check their apps to stay informed on the status of their flights.

“We have seen that there will be impacts to some United flights to and from Denver, but the full impact remains fluid,” said Januska.

As C/NCIA learns more about impacts to travel in and out of Casper, we will work to share timely information.
